CNU XVII: "Experiencing the New Urbanism"
Denver 2009

The **Congress for the New Urbanism** is returning to Denver June 11-14, 2009, and is preparing a regional projects book to illustrate New Urbanism in Colorado. Individuals and firms are invited to submit a project or projects that express the Charter Principles of New Urbanism (www.cnu.org/charter). Nominations of projects are also acceptable.

Selection Criteria:

- Urban environments built since the mid-1990s that contribute to the quality of urban life (ie, are compact, diverse, mixed-use, walkable, linked to transit).
- Projects intended to create such urban environments.
- All project scales--building, block, neighborhood, and region--that express the Charter principles are encouraged.
- Degrees of urbanism: The focus is the quality of urban life, not whether the project is located in an urban center, on the fringe, or in a small town.

What to submit for each project: One to two-page project proposal, 8.5 by 11-inch PDF or JPEG format, with one or two paragraphs of text explaining how the project fulfills the principles of New Urbanism, plus visual material (drawings or photographs).* Please email to: cheney@vmwp.com

*The CNU regional projects book committee may request additional information or visuals before determining which projects will be published. CNU may also use visual material from selected projects for marketing purposes to promote New Urbanism in Colorado.

Call for Key Colorado Urbanists: The regional projects book will also include profiles on individuals who have contributed significantly to New Urbanism in Colorado--architects, planners, developers, landscape architects, public officials, and others.
